Frank writes:

My grandfather, Giuseppe Adamo (Giuseppe Scozzaro, and grandson of Frank Adamo Scozzari(o), immigrated to the U.S. from Santo Stefano Quisquina, Sicily in 1889. He laid rail track and worked in sugar fields of St. Cloud, Florida before migrating to Ybor City, Florida in the early 1890's. He returned to Sicily in 1904 with his wife and their children.

After a year and a half, he returned to Ybor City. He contracted cancer of the face (his forehead) in the 1920's. Salvatore, his oldest grandson (Francesca Adamo Tagliarini's son), was responsible for taking him back and forth to the doctor's (his son). Dr. Frank S. Adamo (my uncle), tried in vain to help him, but he succumbed to the cancer in 1929. He is buried in the Italian Cemetery in Tampa (Ybor City) with his wife and one of their children (Angelina Adamo).

My father (Salvatore Tagliarini) told us the same story about the cancer and having to transport his grandfather to the doctor.
